



### **CREDO Conference**

In May, I had the privilege of attending the CREDO Conference for newly ordained pastors, which is put on by the Board of Pensions. I gathered with 24 other pastors at Ferncliff Camp and Conference Center in beautiful Arkansas for a week of rest, renewal, and refocus on my values and identity.

The Board of Pensions believes we can't have healthy churches if we don't have healthy pastors, so they invest a lot of resources in pastors' wellbeing, which includes CREDO. When they say healthy, they mean all kinds of health! We had faculty to teach and support us on areas of Vocation, Financial Health, Spiritual Health, Physical Health, and Emotional Health. I was grateful for the time, space, and energy to think deeply about these topics and how I want to make big and

small changes to my life in pursuit of better health and balance. Ministry can be demanding, no matter if your church as 50 members or 5,000!
